




The Tech area requires 24 credits and is training for your AFSC – tech school, upgrade training, etc. Some civilian classes can count toward Tech Electives.

LMMS is Leadership, Management, and Military Studies and you need 6 credits. BMT, ALS, NCOA give credits towards this. Civilian management classes and CLEP/DSST exams also apply. Program Electives is the "everything" category and you need 15 credits. Any class that is acceptable for any area of your CCAF will apply here. (Air Force training, natural science, computer science, math, etc.) Check the Civilian Course Conversion Table to make sure the class will count.

The Communication area requires 6 credits. If you are in the 2017 catalog you can have 2 English classes or 1 English and 1 speech. If you are in the 2022 catalog you **must** have 1 English and 1 Speech class.

The Math requirement requires 3 credits or one class. This should be a College Math or higher. Check the Civilian Course Conversion Table (CivCCT) to be certain that your class counts.

The Social Science area requires 3 credits. Possible classes include history, psychology, sociology, etc. The Humanities area requires 3 credits. Possible classes include foreign language, art, ethics, philosophy, etc.
